A reminder that the school photographer will be in school on Tuesday 11th November for each child to have their photograph taken. We will, as in previous years, also have photographs of families taken on the day too.

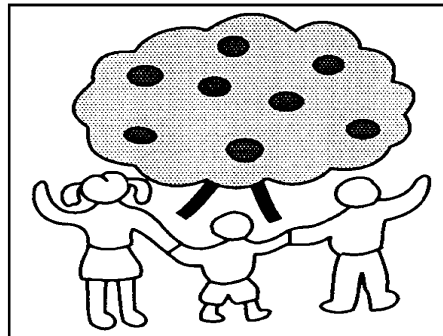
The photographer will be in school from 8.30 am, so if you would like a family photo taken with pre school children and/or older children, please can you all come in to school at 8.30 am.
